1- Write a C program that produces the following text file.

```
1- This is a sample sentence
2- This is a sample sentence
3- This is a sample sentence
4- This is a sample sentence
5- This is a sample sentence
6- This is a sample sentence
7- This is a sample sentence
8- This is a sample sentence
9- This is a sample sentence
10- This is a sample sentence
```

**2-** Write a C program that reads and prints out the sampleTxt.txt file as word by word. For example, it can produce such an output :

```
Swam
over
the
pond
Swim
swan
swim!
Swan
swam
back
again
Well
swum
swam!
```

3- Write a C program that reads and prints out the sampleFile2.txt file as line by line.

```
Swan swam over the pond
Swim swan swim!
Swan swam back again
Well swum swan!
```

**4-** Write a C program that adds(appends) the "This is a tongue-twister example" line into sampleFile2.txt, and then prints out the updated content of the file.

```
This program appends "This is a tongue-twister example" into sampleFile2.

The text written from the file now is below:

Swan swam over the pond

Swim swan swim!

Swan swam back again

Well swum swan!

This is a tongue-twister example
```
