Populating Database

Populating the Database with seeds.rb

You can follow the steps below to populate your database with some data.

1- Create a data model.

2- Then, create an array including record information about that model . You can see an example belongs to myrottenpotatoes project.

We add the following lines to our seed.db file after data model creation named **Movie**

#create a sample movies array

more_movies = [

  {:title => 'Aladdin', :rating => 'G',
   :release_date => '25-Nov-1992'},

  {:title => 'When Harry Met Sally', :rating => 'R',
   :release_date => '21-Jul-1989'},

  {:title => 'The Help', :rating => 'PG-13',
   :release_date => '10-Aug-2011'},

  {:title => 'Raiders of the Lost Ark', :rating => 'PG',
   :release_date => '12-Jun-1981'}

]

more_movies.each do |title, rating, release_date|

  Movie.create( title: title, rating: rating, release_date:
  release_date )

end
```

3- Next, create the table on the database (**rake db:migrate**)

4- Populate your database by using the record information in seed.rb (**rake db:seed**)
